## PRESENTATION AND WORKSHOP MENU FOR JON BIEMER'S 2024 BOOK TOUR

*Our Journey to Sustainability* shares 150 stories of people taking care of the planet through personal action, both modest and extraordinary. This includes 25 nuggets of sustainable wisdom. From the perspective of 40+ year's sustainability-related experience, I offer these presentations.

- "This is what it takes." The question that motivated *Our Journey to Sustainability* is "What motivates people to act on behalf of the earth and her people." I observed that caring, catalysts and collaboration are essential.
- "Bring Spirit to sustainability." There was a time when spirituality, religion and environmentalism were kept separate. No more. Vision quests. Long walks. Honoring creation. Church collections. Collective action. All of this matters!
- "Sustainability wherever you are." Libraries. Trails. Cell phone repair shops. Extraordinary initiatives in small towns. We can all make a difference.
- "Sustainable initiatives in Indigenous Country." I included the work of Indigenous people in the stories have collected. Their history, cultures and current realities speak to what works.
- "The ark of a Collective Handprint." I offer inspiring stories mostly from my previous book is *Our Environmental Handprint*. We have already revived rivers, phased out chlorofluorocarbons, and passed plastic bag bans.

Workshops I share include:

- "Putting the three C's of sustainability into action." Explore how we can help others *care* about the environment, provide *catalysts* to create sustainability, and *collaborate* to help others achieve their sustainable visions.
- "Bring spirit to Sustainability." Claim your inner power to create sustainability. Discover spirit in how you communicate. Connect values and beliefs with actions.
- "Your Environmental Handprints." On outlines of our handprints we write down thing we have done for the environment and things intend to do for the environment. This is a fun interactive activity for all ages.
- "Your climate action plan." As an Organizational Development consultant, I can facilitate a goal-setting meeting relating to sustainability and climate action for your organization.
- "Climate action lessons learned." For those groups that have already embarked on a climate action plan... Let's be a learning organization. How is it going? What needs redirecting?

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
